How can I help my children with their homework?

- Provide supplies and identify resources

- Keep younger siblings off limit from study area.
- Remove distractions such as radio, TV, social phone calls and chatting with friends.
- Let the child do his/her own homework. Do not do the homework for them.
- Motivate your child to do his best.
- Make sure your child does her homework on time.
- When you cannot be of help to your child, you can always contact you're his/her teacher to help, if there's no one in the family that could.
